Dear Brother:--

I have received your communication of the 15th inst. Inclosed are the ~~pxx~~ proofs of the missing pages as mentioned in your letter. I cannot understand the omission. When I left for Cal. last winter or spring, there were some of the pages that had not been prooved and I left it with those in my office to attend to it. Evidently they did not get it straight. I have looked the matter all over, and so explained the missing pages that you will have no difficulty in going right on with the work. You will see that some of the pages you called for are blanks for the department titles, but I have sent proofs of all others except 186. In the copy sent you the chapter ends with 185, but I am compelled to in some way stretch it so it will make another page, to be 186. Pages 187, 188, are blank pages for department title.

My chapter on Christian Science is now nearly ready, and will be sent in a day or two. I will try to copy the next chapter following that, on Pantheism, etc., and then come two chapters already in type. I am doin my best.
