Renting S. Da Churches to
Protestant Denominations

I have just received your request for information concerning the propriety of ~~our~~ renting our church facilities to other Protestant groups. We have no counsel from Sister White on this point, but as a denomination we have taken the position that it is proper to rent our church facilities to conservative Protestant groups. We often find it necessary to rent their churches, and we very frequently rent our churches to such groups. We believe that to do so is in keeping with the spirit of the counsels set forth in Evangelism as to our relationship to the ministers of other denominations, et cetera.

This is a question which comes to us occasionally, and I have talked to some of our leading men about the matter, and the word I am passing on to you represents the consensus of thinking of our leaders.

I trust that this information will be of service to you.
